
## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## Front "Cast a-arm" Control Arm Bushing Replacement Front Wheel Drive 1991-95, Chrysler, Dodge, Plymouth

(Some photos show a stamped a-arm, but the procedure is the same)

Please review instructions before starting the job. You will NOT be removing the bushing outer sleeves!




You'll need to jack up your car, you can't use drive up ramps for this job.




Both front tires/wheels need to be removed. Loosen those lug nuts.




Use jack stands for safety. Put jack stands under frame rails.




Release the anti-sway bar from the a-arms on both sides of the car. You can leave the center bushings tight. Swing it down out of the way.



Remove the bolt that holds the ball joint to the hub/spindle. (red arrow) It takes a wrench and a socket.



Swing down the a-arm. Get ready to have the axle come out of the tranny when you do this, spilling tranny oil. Suggest a catch pan.



a-arm I use this tool, easy to make from large pry bar and hardware store parts.



Remove the a-arm bolts. There are two, in front of the arm and a rear bolt.



After removing the two bolts (per side) remove the a-arm from the car. You may just be able to pull it out or you may need to use a small pry bar.

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
